(https://theatre.illinois.edu/portfolio/john-boesche-scenic-design-head/) will present an overview of making artistic decisions, considerations, etc. in using video projections for the stage and the tools: hardware such as projectors, lenses, & screen surface followed by control software such as Isadora and Q-Lab including attributes of each. John will include his use of WATCHOUT, the industry standard software. Afternoon - Staff at Show Sage will present a demonstration of WATCHOUT, the award-winning production and playback software used globally in theatre productions for scenic projection. It is one of the most widely used digital media systems for theatre, live events, museum exhibits, theme parks, corporate video walls and event spaces, and film and TV production. You will get a detailed look at the production interface and many of the useful features and functions of WATCHOUT. Output will be viewed utilizing two edge-blended projectors to reflect a typical live theatre application of digital media systems.
